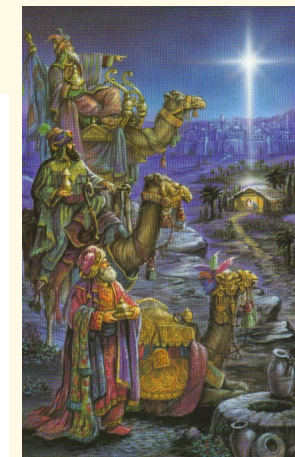
Santiam Area Fire Relief

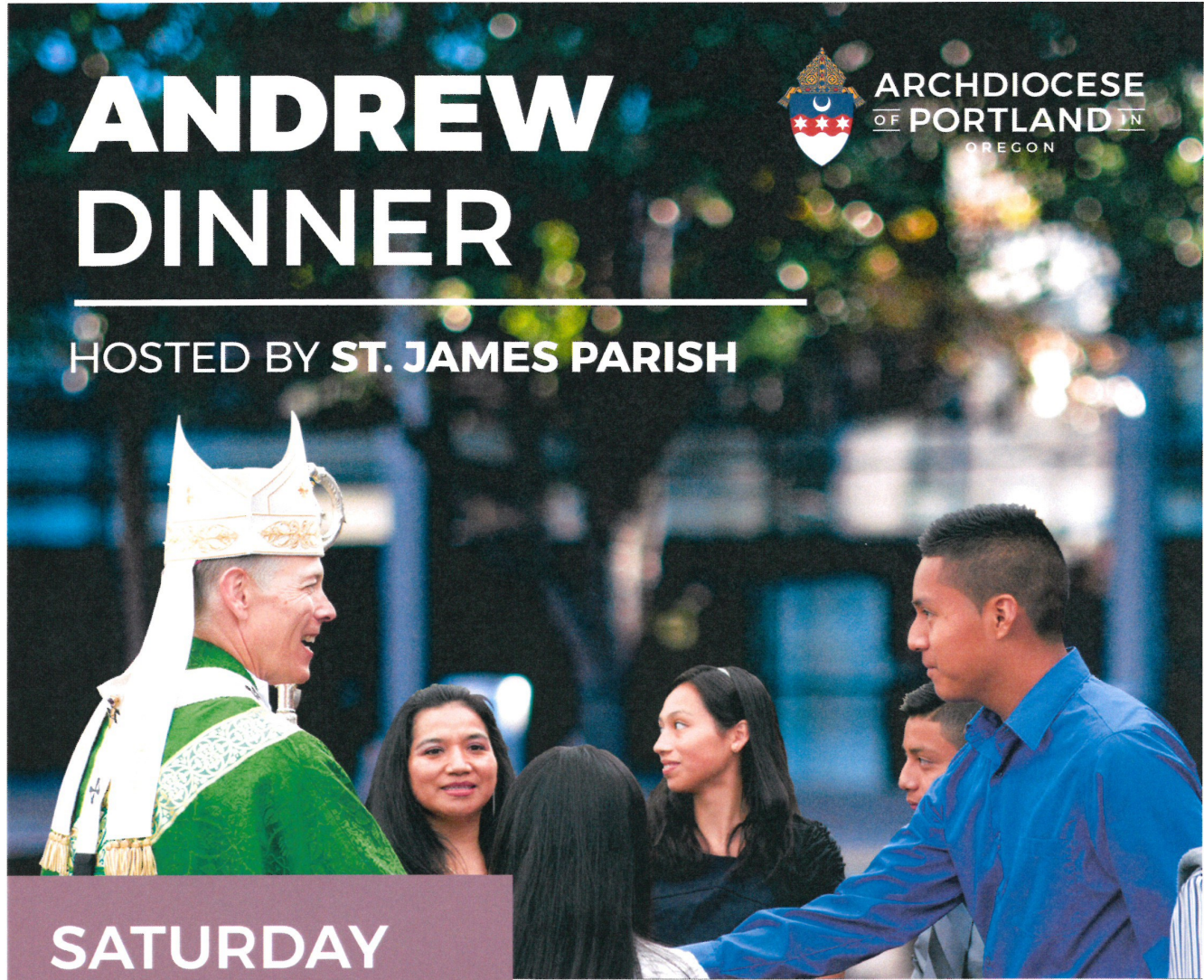

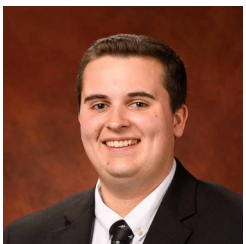
