Fr. Cit's Column

The Christ Event. Two years have passed when we were limited to celebrate the Holy Week as it should. Now, we are back, and we are just in time to celebrate an important series of events of our Church's life, the Paschal Mystery of Christ. The Paschal Mystery is the passion, death and resurrection of Christ. These three events make up the work of God's restoration to save humanity from sin and death, not to say that his birth and all that surround his birth do not belong to it. But the Paschal Mystery specifically points to that purpose where God, by his unlimited mercy, scooped up all who are fallen reinvesting them as heirs of the Kingdom of Heaven.

I am glad that this year we all can be at Church to celebrate these events. I hope everyone will give their attention to these important events and be at Church in order to meditate the passion, death and resurrection of Christ. Why is it necessary?

I think it is necessary to give a part of our time during these important events primarily because God gave us time saving us when we cannot save ourselves. I know many of us do not give a serious look at that anymore. I am not broken. Why would I be restored? Do not fix what is not broken.

Essentially, though we are church goers, we have stopped believing in the mystery of Christ's work. The Most Blessed Sacrament is not as respected and believed as before. The Eucharist is Christ: this is my Body; this is my Blood! Eat and drink so that you may live!

The Paschal Mystery should rekindle our zeal towards the holy, believe in the salvation fulfilled through Christ crucified, and witness to others the truth by persevering in faith. Only the believer perseveres, with consistent effort for an encounter with the holy through the liturgy, church life, the Scriptures, service to the church and the people of God, and many more.-30-

El evento de Cristo. Han pasado dos años en los que nos limitamos a celebrar la Semana Santa como debía. Ahora, estamos de vuelta, y estamos justo a tiempo para celebrar una serie importante de acontecimientos de la vida de nuestra Iglesia, el Misterio Pascual de Cristo. El misterio pascual es la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Cristo. Estos tres eventos conforman la obra de la restauración de Dios para salvar a la humanidad del pecado y la muerte, por no decir que su nacimiento y todo lo que rodea su nacimiento no le pertenecen. Pero el Misterio Pascual apunta específicamente a ese propósito donde Dios, por su misericordia ilimitada, recogió a todos los caídos reinvirtiéndolos como herederos del Reino de los Cielos.

Me alegra que este año todos podamos estar en la Iglesia para celebrar estos eventos. Espero que todos presten su atención a estos importantes acontecimientos y estén en la Iglesia para meditar la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Cristo. ¿Por qué es necesario?

Creo que es necesario dar una parte de nuestro tiempo durante estos eventos importantes principalmente porque Dios nos dio tiempo para salvarnos cuando no podemos salvarnos a nosotros mismos. Sé que muchos de nosotros ya no lo analizamos seriamente. No estoy roto. ¿Por qué me restaurarían? No arregle lo que no está roto.

Esencialmente, aunque somos asistentes a la iglesia, hemos dejado de creer en el misterio de la obra de Cristo. El Santísimo Sacramento no es tan respetado y creído como antes. La Eucaristía es Cristo: este es mi Cuerpo; jesta es mi Sangre! ¡Come y bebe para que puedas vivir! El misterio pascual debe reavivar nuestro celo hacia los santos, creer en la salvación cumplida a través de Cristo crucificado y testimoniar a los demás la verdad perseverando en la fe. Sólo el creyente persevera, con un esfuerzo constante para un encuentro con lo santo a través de la liturgia, la vida de la iglesia, las Escrituras, el servicio a la iglesia y al pueblo de Dios, y muchos más.-30-

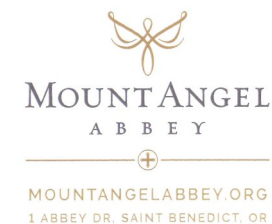
