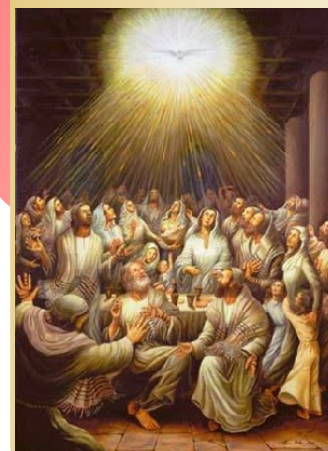

**Fr. Cit's Column** The power of two. Duos are not your ordinary powerhouse. There is balance. There is harmony. There is synergy.

I am thinking of a pair of eyes, a pair of ears, a pair of lips. Well, we can also consider bread and butter, coffee and cream, pen and paper. Probably we can add husband and wife, mentor and learner, producer and the product.

What can two do? As I said, duos are not your ordinary powerhouse. An alliance does better, and the partners' capabilities are doubled. That cannot be defeated. Yes, alliance. In an alliance, a minimal power can be strengthened by adding altogether the available force, strengthening by the number. Putting all strong forces together makes the powerful a force to beat. Even the potential of another can be viable to strengthen an already strong force. Companies that ally with each other make a great business. Independent states that ally with each other become a power to reckon. Friends that join their forces become a mighty group. The power of the Church rests upon being an ally with the Holy Spirit. As she continues to be strengthened by the Holy Spirit, she maintains her life for the Holy Spirit connects her to God, the source of life.

Each of us, members of the Body of Christ, must not be separated from the Church, for through the Church, we get connected to the power of the Holy Spirit. Believe me, once we set ourselves away from Church, then we lose the power that is sourced from the origin of life. There is no flow of grace should we skip Church. We disallow the Holy Spirit to enliven us. Many of our brethren fall into that pit. It is a sad reality that we have to be bothered about as it becomes more and more apparent. The pandemic has added to the loss. I am praying that we connect all that were disconnected to the source of life. May the Holy Spirit enliven their faith again.-30-
