**Fr. Cit's Column** The desires of the flesh is contrary to the Spirit. I do things I hate to do, and I am not proud of it. I am baffled by the many times I neglect that awareness, not so much about the shame I suffered in as much as it is about the failure to learn my lesson. And so the story goes on, as the story of sin and redemption continues until the actualization of the promised heaven. The story of sin and redemption has grace poured generously on the man, actually a bias from a loving God, only if that would benefit him almost always in facing the evils that are planted unwantedly in his heart. Yes, those evils that are within us lead us to thoughts, words and actions that we are not proud of. That sounds like childish, right? Indeed, it is childish. A heart of a child wonders about wants but a childish heart plunges into these wants. A child wonderment has to be channeled to the things of the Lord. In that manner, his desires are actualized in the divine rather than sin and evil. What I like is not always God's will. I need to learn to understand that. If not, I will always be falling to the same wrong desires that my heart chooses. I have to learn to choose God's will over my will.

I don't understand. That is a big deal for us. We want to choose something that we understand well. We are comfortable doing things when we have confidence that we know our choice. What we know, we believe. What we do not know, we reject. What we reject is oftentimes the grace of God. Be reflective and prayerful. The Holy Spirit guides us to see God's hands and hear God's voice.

We are rebels. Despite God warning us: Do not eat of the fruit of the tree of good and evil, we dare it. First, we just want to know the "what if"; then we get accustomed to it, we become habitual sinners. -30-

Sí, esos males que están dentro de nosotros nos llevan a pensamientos, palabras y acciones de los que no estamos orgullosos. Eso suena como infantil, verdad? De hecho, es infantil. Un corazón de un niño se pregunta acerca de los deseos, pero un corazón infantil se sumerge en estos deseos. Un niño maravilloso tiene que canalizarse a las cosas del Señor. De esa manera, sus deseos son actualizados en lo divino más que en el pecado y en el mal.

Lo que me gusta no siempre es la voluntad de Dios. Tengo que aprender a entenderlo. Si no, yo siempre caerá a los mismos deseos equivocados que mi corazón escoge. Tengo que aprender a elegir la voluntad de Dios sobre mi voluntad.

No lo entiendo. Eso es un gran problema para nosotros. Queremos elegir algo que entendemos bien. Estamos cómodos haciendo las cosas cuando tenemos confianza en que conocemos nuestra elección. Lo que sabemos, creemos. Lo que no sabemos, rechazamos. Lo que rechazamos es a menudo la gracia de Dios. Sea reflexivo y orante. El Espíritu Santo nos guía para ver las manos de Dios y escuchar la voz de Dios. Somos rebeldes. A pesar de que Dios nos advierte: No comáis del fruto del árbol del bien y del mal, lo atreveremos. En primer lugar, sólo queremos saber "qué pasa"; luego nos acostumbramos a ello, nos convertimos en pecadores habituales. -30-
