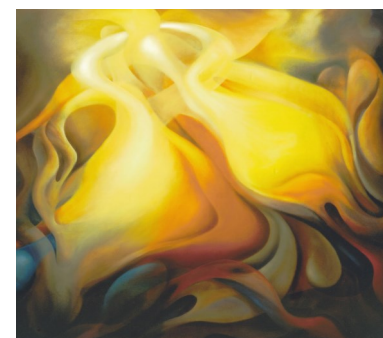

Fr. Cit's Column The future. Foresight is important. Creativity, dynamism, innovativeness, these are some more traits that are necessary to us. When we look at the good, we always associate it as a vision. And vision is forward looking. If I want to see myself a successful entrepreneur 10 years from now, what will take me there? If I want to build a typhoon and earthquake resilient skyscraper, how will I put it up? 68th Annual Pilgrimage August 15, 2022

The 68th Annual Pilgrimage in honor of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven is Monday, August 15th at 7 pm at Holy Rosary Church, outside of Scotts Mills. It will begin with the recitation of the rosary in procession, followed by Mass. The celebrant will be Father Ralph Recker, OSB, pastor.

Holy Rosary Church is the only place in the Portland Archdiocese that has continuously celebrated an annual pilgrimage since Pope Pius XII declared a Marian year in 1954.

Refreshments will be available in the church basement following Mass.

Holy Rosary Church, Crooked Finger, is located in the foothills of the Cascade Mountains. It is 5 miles SE of Scotts Mills, at 21782 Ettlin Loop.
