Fr. Cit's Column

Catholic churches are ornate and majestic. In a "pueblo", it is superimposing. It grabs attention and captivates a beholder. Inside, the altar is ornate; the ceiling is painted, and the windows are like gateway to heaven. It is attractive, full of life and

heavenly.

This image takes me back to the familiar. Huge stone churches built many years ago, usually filled with unique history form part of my growth. The stories told through generations amazed us and helped us appreciate the people of ages past for they gave their strength, skills and life to build these grand monuments. And grander are these people who were forced to do work for the king (or queen). These people have no names. Only a label used to identify them as workers: "Polistas". Great are the enormous ornate churches built from of old, but greater are the "Polistas" who were forced to work and build these churches. They were people of humble origins. In fact, their service to the king (queen) was caused by their inability to pay personal tax. Thus, they pay hours of labor, building these huge edifices that are completed in a decade or more. They made beauty from their humble hands. I can imagine they were worn out by the rigor of the work. Carrying on their unsecured shoulders, thinned by their lack of resources, blocks of heavy boulders that created the temple for the holy.

Striking here is the silent testament of those who paid a huge price to create these beauties. For us who do not know the story, we will only see the beauty towering before us. We only appreciate the undeniable beauty of the work however not see the contribution of the humble workers. Needless to say, these ornate and majestic churches will never be beautiful without the service of the humble.

If by chance we visit a stone church anywhere in the world, besides being mesmerized by the beauty, you will be intrigued by birds sheltered in the fortress. These refugee birds are symbols of humility. Their songs must be heard for within the melodious singing is an invitation to see the humble servants who built these beauties. -30-


On the day of the picnic, you may bring beverage and or dessert to share. You can bring family and friends during the event. See you there.

Mission Melchizedech (Seminarian Fund)

I have recently launched an apostolate for Filipino seminarians, who are poor but deserving students. How it started traces back when I started paying for a former classmate's seminary dues due to his former sponsor's passing away. I saw myself in his predicament. Filipino seminarians pay their own studies until ordination. Glad I was able to help pay his seminary dues. He will be ordained a deacon for the Marian Society of the Holy Redeemer, a new found society. After he finished seminary in 2022, I continued to help seminarians pay either their seminary fees or incidental school spending. Ivan James Labini is one of the seminarians. Some of you from this parish helped me buy a laptop for his online schooling. By God's grace, through your generosity, we were able to buy his laptop and pay almost all of his seminary dues. Now he is a High School Senior. He needs to raise 75,000 pesos (roughly \$ 1,400.00 in today's exchange rate) to pay for his year's fees. With Ivan James are three other seminarians who receive a 2,500 pesos (roughly \$45.00) for allowance to pay incidental school spending.
