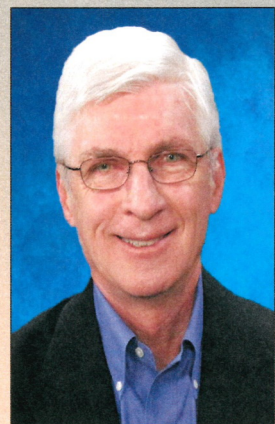

Fr. Cit's Column Preparation. We prepare and we write plan for anything special and grand. We want success. That success will only happen if we intentionally draw a blueprint. A road map towards success includes a lot of details.

We put together all resources and choose great minds necessary, avoiding at all cost mistakes and setbacks. That is how we ensure that what we do we are secured and prepared. Gathering is essential in preparation. Gathering puts together necessary elements to the planned goal. Recruitment is one kind of gathering done meticulously, pairing, fitting all good minds to other non-human resources.

In Jesus' mission he gathered men. Twelve of them, and then the seventy-two and so on. He also added Paul (Saul). With them are women whose names were also identified in the Gospels, the likes of Martha, Mary, Magdalene. All of them, for Christ were great hearts and souls. They were the disciples who stayed with Jesus and continued the ministry he left to the early Christian community. Although, we cannot deny that one chosen with them all has not maintained the expectation to realize the community's goals, but still his inclusion played a part in the fulfillment of God's plan.

Who to recruit? There are plenty of skills. Say, the need for an engineer to fill a company's vacancy can see thousands of engineers, all of them qualified, but one will surely be hired. He is the best fit for the company's mission and vision and the company's sets of values.

That is the same framework Christ used when he called his twelve apostles. All of them, distinct, and yet profess the same faith in God and live in the manner Jesus lived his own life.

I guess when God calls us to live in the eternal Kingdom in heaven, the same method of choosing will be employed: the weeds to the burning fire, the wheats to the Shiloh. -30-

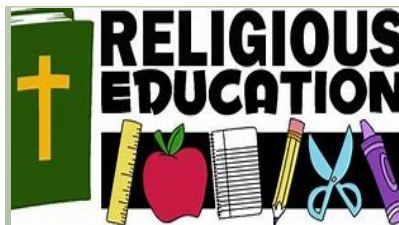

Mission Melchizedech (Seminarist Fund)

I have recently launched an apostolate for Filipino seminarians, who are poor but deserving students. How it started traces back when I started paying for a former classmate's seminary dues due to his former sponsor's passing away. I saw myself in his predicament. Filipino seminarians pay their own studies until ordination. Glad I was able to help pay his seminary dues. He will be ordained a deacon for the Marian Society of the Holy Redeemer, a new found society. After he finished seminary in 2022, I continued to help seminarians pay either their seminary fees or incidental school spending. Ivan James Labini is one of the seminarians. Some of you from this parish helped me buy a laptop for his online schooling. By God's grace, through your generosity, we were able to buy his laptop and pay almost all of his seminary dues. Now he is a High School Senior. He needs to raise 75,000 pesos (roughly \$ 1,400.00 in today's exchange rate) to pay for his year's fees. With Ivan James are three other seminarians who receive a 2,500 pesos (roughly \$45.00) for allowance to pay incidental school spending. I launched the apostolate to bring together generous people who has the same vision like mine and also to pool together resources to ease each other's weight of responsibility. When two or more carry the weight, it lightens the burden.



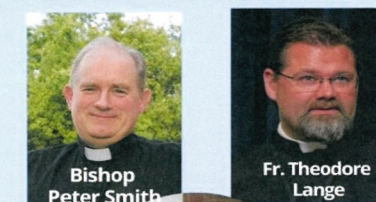
