**Fr. Cit's Column**

Communal praise. St. Paul's ideal of communal worship is a devotion of hearts bound by peace, unity and love. At the heart of St. Paul's liturgy is gathering around the one who gathers. The point of this gathering is to celebrate Jesus present in the Sacrament. And Christ being the center of this gathering, it is not just any celebration. St. Paul pleads to the community of believers to remain faithful to the purpose of the gathering. Jesus gathers. However, the growing community sees plenty of unforeseen new things. Through it, there is confusion. In the midst of confusion, the community is divided. Factions are created. There are those who are excluded. Differences become so salient groups do not care for each other. So in the Eucharistic meal, there are those who are not welcome. And worst, those who take part in the meal have reduced the Eucharistic meal to a party and they get drunk. Our Eucharistic celebrations are in the care of the local bishop, and his authority is delegated to the pastors. The pastors are the bishop's cooperators making sure the liturgy of the Church is faithful to the mind of the God.

Let me just mention where we are in this ruse where factions argue over liturgy. I am not going to expound or attempt to give my own opinion on the matter. There is no attempt to give any solution about the issue. The Traditional or Latin Mass (also the Extraordinary form) was ordered stop of use through a Motu Proprio issued by Pope Francis, but giving the local bishops a limited authority to allow its use on certain conditions careful not to defeat the purpose of the Motu Proprio *Traditionis Custodes*.

Recently Shia LaBeouf said on Bishop Barron's interview shown through media platforms that the Traditional Mass has cut deep into his consciousness and led him to love the Catholic liturgy. He said the Traditional Mass is not like the Novus Ordo because the Traditional Mass is not like selling him a merchandise. It is a liturgy as it is and draws you in and making you engaged and be part of it. -30-

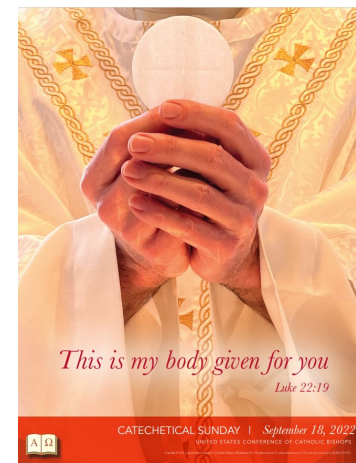

Hay quienes están excluidos. Las diferencias se convierten en grupos sobresalientes que no se preocupan unos por otros. Así que en la Cena Eucarística, hay quienes no son Bienvenido. Y lo peor es que los que participan en la comida han reducido la comida eucarística a una fiesta y se emborrachan.

Nuestras celebraciones eucarísticas están bajo el cuidado del obispo local, y su autoridad es delegada a los pastores. Los pastores son los cooperadores del obispo, asegurando que la liturgia de la Iglesia sea fiel a la mente de Dios.

Permítanme mencionar dónde estamos en este alboroto donde las facciones discuten sobre la liturgia. No voy a exponer ni intentar dar mi propia opinión al respecto. No hay ningún intento de dar ninguna solución al problema. La Misa tradicional o latina (también la forma extraordinaria) fue ordenada la parada del uso a través de un Motu Proprio emitido por el Papa Francisco, pero dando a los obispos locales una autoridad limitada para permitir su uso en ciertas condiciones, con cuidado de no derrotar el propósito del Motu Proprio *Traditionis Custodes*.

Recientemente, el Shia LaBeouf dijo en la entrevista del Obispo Barron, que mostró a través de plataformas de medios de comunicación que la misa tradicional ha penetrado profundamente en su conciencia y lo ha llevado a amar la liturgia católica. Dijo que la Misa tradicional no es como el Novus Ordo porque la Misa tradicional no es como venderle una mercancía. Es una liturgia tal como es y atrae a los chupa y haciendo que se comprometan y sean parte de ella. -30-
