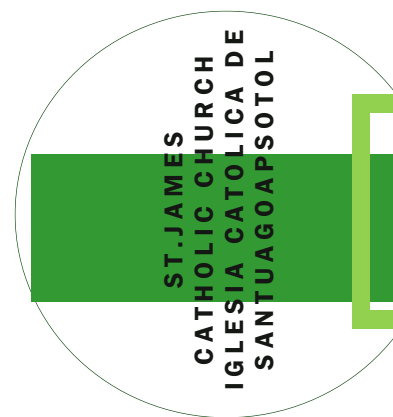

**Fr. Cit's Column** Preaching, a risky business. One of those preachers ever present on the internet and varied media is Bishop Robert Barron. His impact is broad, ranging from those who follow him and use his works for a good purpose to those who follow him with the intent to break him or break his good works. According to him, he was reluctant at first to explore the media. However, his staff cajoled him incessantly. He gave it a try, though feeling unconvinced that he would succeed. Only hoping for a few, he was given a great multitude for an audience. His recent book on the Eucharist, This Is My Body, aimed at being handed to 1,000,000 Catholics already passed its mark. However, the Word on Fire, his Evangelization arm, has to continue printing the book because orders have not stopped coming. Bishop Barron's podcasts, YouTube videos, digital records on varied internet platforms are well viewed by the millions. Commenting on his success, he mentioned challenges that came his way were from intelligent people who have the same passion to preach. He said, many tried to dissuade him to continue his work. What sustained him was faith. He realized that, like any other preacher, evangelization is preaching Christ, preaching the truth. If the truth is preached, the work continues. I am a fan. I have so much respect for his works (also in his character, values and faith). To a follower (term for an internet subscriber to a work), Bishop Robert Barron is a force to be reckoned with. He is well-educated, intelligent, eloquent and kind. He knows what he says, and he lives what he preaches. He persuades more evangelizers to come out and accompany him in his work. His advice to daring preachers: study, pray and always update.-30-

La predicación, un negocio arriesgado. Uno de esos predicadores siempre presentes en Internet y en los variados medios de comunicación es el obispo Robert Barron. Su impacto es amplio, desde aquellos que lo siguen y usan sus obras para un buen propósito hasta aquellos que lo siguen con la intención de romperlo o romper sus buenas obras. Según él, al principio se mostró reacio a explorar los medios de comunicación. Sin embargo, su personal lo engatusó incesantemente. Lo intentó, aunque no se sintió convencido de que tendría éxito. Solo esperando unos pocos, se le dio una gran multitud para una audiencia. Su reciente libro sobre la Eucaristía, This Is My Body, destinado a ser entregado a 1.000.000 de católicos ya pasó su marca. Sin embargo, la Palabra en Fuego, su brazo de Evangelización, tiene que seguir imprimiendo el libro porque las órdenes no han dejado de llegar. Los podcasts del obispo Barron, los videos de YouTube, los registros digitales en variadas plataformas de Internet son bien vistos por millones. Al comentar sobre su éxito, mencionó que los desafíos que se le presentaron fueron de personas inteligentes que tienen la misma pasión por predicar. Dijo que muchos trataron de disuadirlo para continuar su trabajo. Lo que lo sostenía era la fe. Se dio cuenta de que, como cualquier otro predicador, evangelizar es predicar a Cristo, predicar la verdad. Si se predica la verdad, la obra continúa. Soy un fan. Tengo mucho respeto en sus obras (también en su carácter, valores y fe). Para un seguidor (término para un suscriptor de Internet a una obra), el obispo Robert Barron es una fuerza a tener en cuenta. Es bien educado, inteligente, elocuente y amable. Él sabe lo que dice, y vive lo que predica. Persuade a más evangelizadores para que salgan y lo acompañen en su trabajo. Su consejo a los predicadores audaces: estudia, ora y siempre actualiza.-30-
