Fr. Cit's Column

Fortitude. When God sends a disciple to a mission, they go trusting the Lord's guidance and sup-

port (providence). Let's take for example the character of Moses. He heard the Lord's call amidst insecurity and confusion. His heart was torn for charity to a slave, who he realized was his kin. He fled to the desert for his life. And then the Lord told him to go back to Egypt to free his people. "Why me?" Moses protested. He protested because he did not know the Lord. And since he did not know the Lord, he did not understand the big task he needed to complete. Right, it is easier for our effort to be put together when we have ownership of the task.

I like to be involved in a project that resonates my character and vision. Sad though that those projects I was interested to be involved in I was not invited to take part on. My mistake was letting the chance pass by not having the courage to volunteer.

Mainly it was due to timidity.




