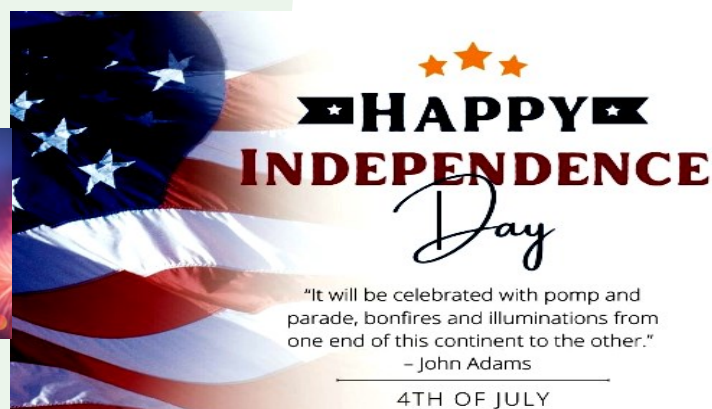
**Fr. Cit's Column** There may be equality. Communism. The Christians of the ancient Church have concern for each other's welfare. Each member contributes their wealth according to their ability, put together, and distribute to all members according to need, so that no one may be found needy. Communism in the Church's perspective is not an economic system but a respect for God given resources and care for the dignity of all human beings. Church communism is against personal gain or profit. It spouses the divine order of the true good, the common good. Economic gains are not necessarily discouraged, but greed and fraudulent activities are abhorred. In the normal enterprise of man, each earner varies in their valued success. The disadvantaged are helped by those who have better success. But that does not mean the materially disadvantaged are actually spared from contributing. In fact, they, too, are contributors, maybe not financially, but other resources they abundantly have like skills, time, and even prayers. As the community developed to what it is now, the Church has become the largest charitable institution distributing help and welfare to all the disadvantaged, aimed at alleviating the poor's predicament. The church's charity work provides social welfare that is in principle social welfare anchored on the divine nature of the good and the basic church teaching that man is made in the likeness and goodness of God. That means the church charity does not only deliver help but promotes a wholistic wellbeing of a person, which is, in the words of St. Irenaeus, "fully human, fully alive. The Caritas Internationalis is the umbrella organization of the Vatican. It mobilizes all the charity organizations the Catholic Church runs all over the world. -30-

Puede haber igualdad. Comunismo. Los cristianos de la Iglesia antigua se preocupan por el bienestar de los demás. Cada miembro contribuye con sus riquezas según su capacidad, las junta y las distribuye a todos los miembros según sus necesidades, para que nadie sea hallado necesitado. El comunismo, desde la perspectiva de la Iglesia, no es un sistema económico, sino un respeto por los recursos dados por Dios y el cuidado de la dignidad de todos los seres humanos. El comunismo eclesial está en contra de la ganancia o beneficio personal. Abraza el orden divino del verdadero bien, el bien común. No necesariamente se desalientan las ganancias económicas, pero se aborrece la codicia y las actividades fraudulentas. En la empresa normal del hombre, cada asalariado varía en su valioso éxito. Los desfavorecidos son ayudados por los que tienen más éxito. Pero eso no significa que los materialmente desfavorecidos estén realmente exentos de contribuir. De hecho, ellos también son contribuyentes, puede que no financieramente, pero tal vez otros recursos que tienen en abundancia, como habilidades, tiempo e incluso oraciones. A medida que la comunidad se desarrolló, en cuanto a lo que es ahora, la Iglesia se ha convertido en la institución caritativa más grande que distribuye ayuda y bienestar a todos los desfavorecidos, con el objetivo de aliviar la difícil situación de los pobres. El trabajo de caridad de la iglesia proporciona bienestar social que es, en principio, bienestar social anclado en la naturaleza divina del bien y en la enseñanza básica de la iglesia de que el hombre está hecho a semejanza y bondad de Dios. Eso significa que la caridad de la iglesia no solo brinda ayuda, sino que promueve un bienestar integral de una persona, que es, en palabras de San Ireneo, "completamente humano, completamente vivo. Caritas Internationalis es la organización paraguas del Vaticano. Moviliza a todas las organizaciones de caridad que la Iglesia Católica dirige en todo el mundo.-30-
