Parish Associations, Societies and Councils:

Altar Society:

The Altar Society also takes care of our Sanctuary primarily with candles, flowers, and liturgical decorations.





Dear St James Family,

This past fiscal year has been one of transitions and blessings! We bid farewell to Patti Parks and thanked her for all of her devoted years of service at St James. We continue to keep Patti and Pat Parks in our prayers. Having assumed the position of Pastoral Associate for St James in October 2023, I've been deeply blessed with willing mentors guiding me in serving our parish.

As you can see from this annual report, we are an extremely active, generous parish! Our financial reports demonstrate that we are caring for our parish property and investing in the education of our youth, as well as evangelizing our community. We are re-instituting a formal parish Finance Committee beginning this fiscal year, reporting to the Parish Council. Marilyn Kendoll, Monica Bergmann, and Kent Burtner have generously volunteered their time to review and provide guidance on parish finances. Also, if you feel called to become a member of the Parish Council, please make that calling known to us so that we may begin that process for you.

We had an extremely successful July 4th, 2023 Chicken BBQ event, with approximately \$9,000.00 net profit raised in support of the parish. And, our annual auction this year, April 13th, raised approximately \$33,500.00 net profit for the parish. The incredible efforts of you and all of our volunteers always create outstanding results at all of our parish events. We are truly blessed with the family we have at St James.

As noted in the property maintenance matrix, we encountered a few unanticipated maintenance issues, but overcame them without too much difficulty. We are continuing to invest in routine property maintenance. Our spring grounds clean up saw many volunteers, some with heavy equipment, show up to clean our parish grounds and distribute 60 yards of new bark dust in our beds. Our grounds look amazing thanks to your dedication!

Our budget for this fiscal year (1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025) tracks this past fiscal year, with a 3% projected increase in most categories, but no radical shifts in programming. All budget documents, financial statements and Finance Committee and Parish Council Meeting Minutes are available to you for review.


