### Fr. Cit's Column

When a pope dies. The Universal Church mourns for the death of a beloved shepherd, Pope Francis. News came when we were still asleep that the Pope passed away due to stroke and cardiac arrest. We know Pope Francis had been in the hospital for a serious ailment and was battling for his life, thanks to his doctors, he was discharged from Gemelli Hospital, though was not totally free from danger. Despite his condition, he still managed to do some work and meet people and address his audience. On Easter Monday (Rome time), the Pope went home to the Lord.

When a pope dies, the Papacy becomes vacant (*sede vacante*). The Camerlengo becomes in-charge of the papal affairs until a new pope is elected. The Camerlengo's interim authority is limited only to the disposition of the daily affairs of the Vatican City and its assets and properties. Also, it is the Camerlengo who confirms and announces the death of the pope. Thus, Cardinal Kevin Farrell is currently the Cardinal in-charge of the Vatican City and he made the death of Pope Francis public.

In the succeeding days, the Cardinals will be very busy. First, they gather in the Vatican City to reflect upon the death of Pope Francis, and to honor his legacy, and then to prepare for the conclave. The wake for Pope Francis' remains started on Wednesday and then on Saturday he will be interred. In Pope Francis' will, he wished to be buried at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. The basilica is frequented by Pope Francis for prayers. Meanwhile the Cardinal-electors are summoned to the Vatican City by the dean of the College of Cardinals, Cardinal Giovanni Battista Re. The cardinals whose age is above 80 and are no longer cardinal-electors are still invited to the Vatican City and they are free to decide whether they fly to the Vatican.

Cuando un Papa muere. La Iglesia Universal lamenta la muerte de un amado pastor, el Papa Francisco. Llegaron noticias cuando todavía estábamos dormidos de que el Papa falleció debido a un derrame cerebral y paro cardíaco. Sabemos que el Papa Francisco había estado en el hospital por una grave dolencia y estaba luchando por su vida, gracias a sus médicos, fue dado de alta del Hospital Gemelli, aunque no estaba totalmente libre de peligro. A pesar de su condición, se las arregló para hacer algo de trabajo, conocer gente y dirigirse a su público. El Lunes de Pascua (hora de Roma), el Papa se fue a casa con el Señor.

Cuando un papa muere, el papado queda vacante (*sede vacante*). El Camerlengo se convierte en el encargado de los asuntos papales hasta que un nuevo Papa es elegido. La autoridad provisional del Camerlengo se limita solo a la disposición de los asuntos cotidianos de la Ciudad del Vaticano y sus bienes y propiedades. Además, es el Camerlengo quien confirma y anuncia la muerte del Papa. Así, el cardenal Kevin Farrell es actualmente el cardenal encargado de la Ciudad del Vaticano e hizo pública la muerte del papa Francisco.

En los días siguientes, los Cardenales estarán muy ocupados. Primero, se reúnen en la Ciudad del Vaticano para reflexionar sobre la muerte del Papa Francisco, para honrar su legado, y luego para prepararse para el cónclave. La estela de los restos del Papa Francisco comenzó el miércoles y luego el sábado será enterrado. En la voluntad del Papa Francisco, deseaba ser enterrado en la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor. La basílica es frecuentada por el Papa Francisco para oraciones.

Mientras tanto, los cardenales electores son convocados a la Ciudad del Vaticano por el decano del Colegio Cardenalicio, el cardenal Giovanni Battista Re. Los cardenales cuya edad es superior a 80 años y ya no son cardenales electores todavía están invitados a la Ciudad del Vaticano, pero son libres de decidir si vuelan al Vaticano.
