Fr. Cit's Column

Prevost. French, old form provost, which means to place in charge. It is a status name for many various public officials in a position of responsibility (source: family search.org).

In the recently concluded Conclave, the Eminence Robert Francis Cardinal Prevost was elected St. Peter's 266th successor. Particularly raving about this election are Americans, as the new pope hails from Chicago, Illinois. For sure his election, which was never on any one's radar, was a generous surprise.

Cardinal Prevost has a French and Spanish lineage. The family had involvements in leadership running specific committees that facilitated fulfillment of goals. Robert Francis was a teacher. Later he was called to the ministry joining the Augustinians. His leadership was honed when he was chosen to lead the local province of Augustinians in Chicago. And that was only the beginning, for he held various roles in the Augustinians here and also in Peru until he became the General Master of the Order of St. Augustin worldwide. While he might already have had a worldwide authority, that must have been an initiation to what he would become, leading not only a small chunk of Catholics worldwide, but this time the 1.4 billion Catholics worldwide, all of them.

That became possible when he became the bishop in his former Peruvian missions. And then later on he was called to Rome, made a cardinal by Pope Francis in 2023, and was made head prefect of the dicastery of bishops.

18 He was not mentioned among frontrunners, since there is never is a "frontrunner" except through the eyes of outsiders. But the choice of this cardinal was made feasible by the discerning cardinals on the future of the Universal Church vis-à-vis current and impelling realities in the world.

19 He chose Leo for his name. He said, with artificial intelligence making tremendous impact all over,
20 a Leo would be necessary (alluding to Pope Leo XIII and the commencement of the new world and
21 it's challenges).

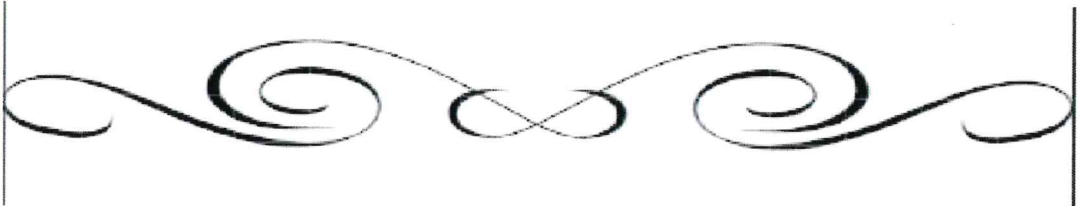

En el recientemente concluido Cónclave, el Eminencia Robert Francisco Cardenal Prevost fue elegido el 266o sucesor de San Pedro. Particularmente entusiasmados por esta elección son los estadounidenses porque el nuevo Papa proviene de Chicago, Illinois. Sin duda su elección, que nunca estuvo en el radar de nadie, fue una sorpresa generosa.

El Cardenal Prevost tiene un linaje francés y español. La familia participaba en el liderazgo dirigiendo un comité específico que facilitaba el cumplimiento de los objetivos. Robert Francis fue profesor. Más tarde fue llamado al ministerio uniéndose a los agustinos. Su liderazgo se perfeccionó cuando fue elegido para dirigir la provincia local de Agustinos en Chicago. Y eso fue solo el comienzo, ya que desempeñó varios papeles en los agustinos aquí y también en Perú hasta que se convirtió en el Maestro General de la Orden de San Agustín en todo el mundo. Si bien él ya tenía una autoridad mundial, eso debió haber sido una iniciación a lo que se convertiría, dirigiendo no solo a una pequeña porción de católicos en todo el mundo, sino esta vez a los 1.4 mil millones de católicos en todo el mundo, todos ellos.

Eso fue posible cuando se convirtió en obispo en sus antiguas misiones peruanas. Y más tarde fue llamado a Roma, hecho cardenal por el Papa Francisco en 2023, y fue nombrado prefecto jefe del dicasterio de los obispos.

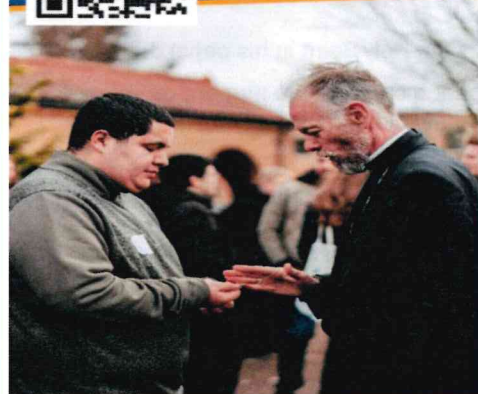
