Fr. Cit's Column

Do not forget the works of the Lord (Psalm 78:7b). Two new saints: St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Carlo Acutis. Both loved God authentically. They lived saintly lives according to their calling, according to the needs of their time. Saint Pier Giorgio influenced poor Italian youth to love Christ as much as he did. When they were together, he would always tell them about Christ. At every opportunity, he taught them prayers, especially the rosary. St. Carlo, on the other hand, spread devotion to the Eucharist by putting on website Eucharistic miracles. This millennial saint impressed many devotees and faith seekers about the love of the Eucharist.

We need these two heroes for the world to see the love of God. More appropriately, the youth need these two heroes to tell them of the love of God, to help them see and experience that God and his works are true.

Today, we know that to be a saint is not obsolete, or a classic, or only for the reserved few. In fact, sainthood is the path each of us is taking. We must live it. We must be intentional living it. No part-timers. It is either you are in or you're not.

The youth are making a faith revolution. I am hoping it is actually happening locally. The public awareness has it that there is a revival for the holy and divine among the youth all over the world. When Pope Benedict XVI encouraged the liturgy to be celebrated in the extraordinary form (Latin Rite), the desire for the sacred among the young was tickled.

They loved the liturgy. As a commencement, they actively left the loud and vibrant celebrations characterized by the concert liturgies for the solemn celebration of the Mass in Latin and the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Here in the US, a model of such revival can be experienced in the Archdiocese of Detroit. *Juventutem* (youth, in English) is a Catholic group that supports Latin rite liturgies. >

Cuando estaban juntos, siempre les hablaba de Cristo. En cada oportunidad, les enseñó oraciones, especialmente el rosario. San Carlo, por otro lado, difundió la devoción a la Eucaristía al poner en el sitio web milagros eucarísticos. Este santo milenar impresionó a muchos devotos y buscadores de fe sobre el amor a la Eucaristía.

Necesitamos a estos dos héroes para que el mundo vea el amor de Dios. Más apropiadamente, los jóvenes necesitan que estos dos héroes les hablen del amor de Dios, para ayudarles a ver y experimentar que Dios y sus hazañas son verdaderas.

Hoy sabemos que ser santo no es obsoleto, ni un clásico, o solo para unos pocos reservados. De hecho, la santidad es el camino que cada uno de nosotros está tomando.

Debemos vivirlo. Debemos ser intencionales viviéndolo. No hay trabajadores a tiempo parcial. Es o estás en él o no.

Los jóvenes están haciendo una revolución de fe. Espero que realmente esté sucediendo localmente.

La conciencia pública dice que hay un avivamiento de lo santo y divino entre los jóvenes de todo el mundo. Cuando el Papa Benedicto XVI ha alentado a que la liturgia se celebre en la forma extraordinaria (rito latino), el deseo de lo sagrado entre los jóvenes se sintió cosquilleado. Les encantaba la liturgia. Como comienzo, abandonaron activamente las celebraciones fuertes y vibrantes caracterizadas por las liturgias de los conciertos para la celebración solemne de la Misa en latín y la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento.

Aquí en los Estados Unidos, un modelo de tal renacimiento puede ser experimentado en la Arquidiócesis de Detroit. *Juventutem* (juventud, en Español) es un grupo católico que apoya las liturgias de rito latino.>




