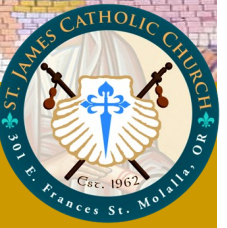

Fr. Cit's Column The fear of the Lord. No, I am not talking about powerlessly submitting one's will to a superpower or face severe punishment or even cost your life for not obeying. The fear of the Lord is persevering to live a righteous way of life. Psalm 111:10 says, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom. Prudent are all who practice it". He who understands perseveres in faithfulness the things he knows and proves his respect and honor to what he understood. The Catechism (CCC1831) identifies Fear of the Lord as one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. He who fears the Lord perfects Christian virtues. How so? In what manner? CCC explains by differentiating filial fear versus servile fear. Filial fear is not servile because a child would act upon commandments with love and a posture of respect for parents or siblings.

In the Parable of the Two Sons, the father sent his two sons to work. The first son gave the father a "no" for a reply. The second son said "yes". But later, the son who said no went and did the work while the second son failed on his yes. The first son had a change of mind for the good. Change of mind (or heart) for the good means repentance. Repentance is the fruit of the son's inner examination of his thoughts, words and actions. Realizing he was wrong for saying "no" to his father, he progressed in virtue by honoring not his word or right, but the love he and his father has to each other. He went to do what his father commanded of him. Fear of the Lord helps us better our Christian virtues. By understanding our own person in relation to God and to others, we persevere to be obedient disciples and eager to be formed.>

El temor del Señor. No, no estoy hablando de someter impotentemente la voluntad de uno a una superpotencia o enfrentar un castigo severo o incluso costarle la vida por no obedecer. El temor del Señor es perseverar para vivir una forma de vida justa. Salmo 111:10 dice, "El temor del Señor es el principio de la Sabiduría. Prudentes son todos los que lo practican". El que entiende persevera en la fidelidad de las cosas que sabe y demuestra su respeto y honor a lo que entendió.

El Catecismo (CCC1831) identifica el Temor al Señor como uno de los dones del Espíritu Santo. El que teme al Señor perfecciona las virtudes cristianas. ¿Cómo es eso? ¿De qué manera? CCC explica diferenciando el miedo filial versus el miedo servil. El miedo filial no es servil porque un niño actuaría según los mandamientos con amor y una postura de respeto por los padres o hermanos.

En la parábola de los dos hijos, el padre envió a sus dos hijos a trabajar. El primer hijo le dio al padre un "no" para una respuesta. El segundo hijo dijo "sí". Pero más tarde, el hijo que dijo que no fue e hizo el trabajo mientras que el segundo hijo falló en su sí. El primer hijo tuvo un cambio de mentalidad para bien.

Cambio de mente (o corazón) para el bien significa arrepentimiento. El arrepentimiento es el fruto del examen interno del hijo de sus pensamientos, palabras y acciones. Al darse cuenta de que estaba equivocado por decir «no» a su padre, progresó en virtud al honrar no su palabra o derecho, sino el amor que él y su padre se tienen el uno al otro.

Fue a hacer lo que su padre le ordenó.
 El temor del Señor nos ayuda a mejorar nuestras virtudes cristianas. Al entender nuestra propia persona en relación con Dios y con los demás, perseveramos para ser discípulos obedientes y ansiosos de ser formados.>


