Catechetical Corner:

We encourage you to read, reflect, and pray regarding the Holy Father's Encyclical "Magnifica Humanitas." Published on May 25, 2026, and signed on May 15, 2026, Magnifica Humanitas ("Magnificent Humanity") is Pope Leo XIV's inaugural encyclical, marking a significant contribution to the Church's social teaching in the context of modern technology and AI. The encyclical emphasizes the centrality of the human person, the dignity of work, social justice, and the common good, while warning against the concentration of technological power and the risks of dehumanization.

Pope Leo XIV has also repeatedly emphasized the importance of reading and living out the Dogmatic Constitution Dei Verbum from the Second Vatican Council, framing it as a central guide for understanding God's Revelation and the Church's mission.

In his General Audience of 4 February 2026, the Pope described Dei Verbum as "one of the most beautiful and important" Council documents, highlighting that Sacred Scripture is a "privileged space for encounter" where God continues to speak to people of every time. Publicada el 25 de mayo de 2026 y firmada el 15 de mayo de 2026, Magnifica Humanitas ("Magnífica Humanidad") es la encíclica inaugural del Papa León XIV, marcando una contribución significativa a la doctrina social de la Iglesia en el contexto de la tecnología moderna y la IA. La encíclica enfatiza la centralidad de la persona humana, la dignidad del trabajo, la justicia social y el bien común, al tiempo que advierte contra la concentración del poder tecnológico y los riesgos de deshumanización.

El Papa León XIV también ha enfatizado repetidamente la importancia de leer y vivir la Constitución Dogmática Dei Verbum del Concilio Vaticano II, presentándola como una guía central para entender la Revelación de Dios y la misión de la Iglesia.

En su Audiencia General del 4 de febrero de 2026, el Papa describió Dei Verbum como "uno de los documentos conciliares más bellos e importantes", destacando que la Sagrada Escritura es un "espacio privilegiado para el encuentro" donde Dios sigue hablando a las personas de todos los tiempos. 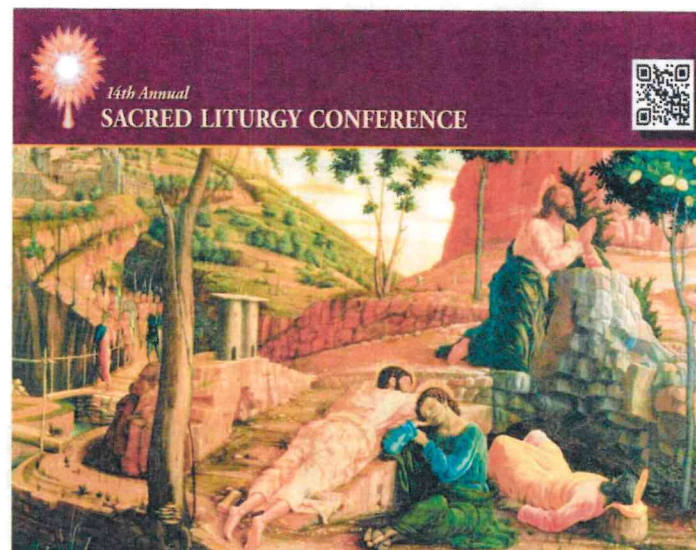

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Visiting the Homebound: Making visits to people who cannot get to Mass is a special ministry. It involves a social time for many and a chance to pray with and for the needs of that person. There is also a short rite used when the Holy Eucharist is given. If you would like to be a part of this team, call the office 503-829-2080.

Religious Education: We always need good people to teach our children about the Catholic Faith and to prepare them for receiving the Sacraments. 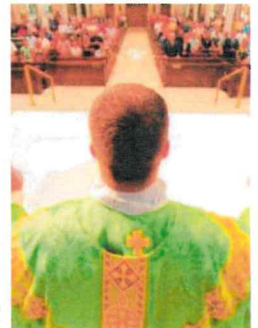
