

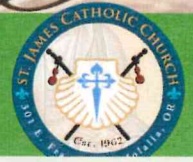

Psalm 103: A Praise and Gratitude Psalm

Psalm 103, attributed to King David, is a heartfelt expression of worship and thanksgiving. David begins by urging his own soul to bless the Lord, emphasizing that praise should come from the whole being, not just outward words. David praises God for forgiving all sins and healing all diseases, recognizing that spiritual and physical restoration are gifts from God. Forgiveness is central, as it reconciles humanity to God and brings profound spiritual relief, while healing reflects God's care for the whole person. The psalm emphasizes that God's love and righteousness extend beyond human life, from generation to generation. His sovereignty ensures justice, mercy, and care over all creation, and His kingdom is established in heaven.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Visiting the Homebound: Making visits to people who cannot get to Mass is a special ministry. It involves a social time for many and a chance to pray with and for the needs of that person. 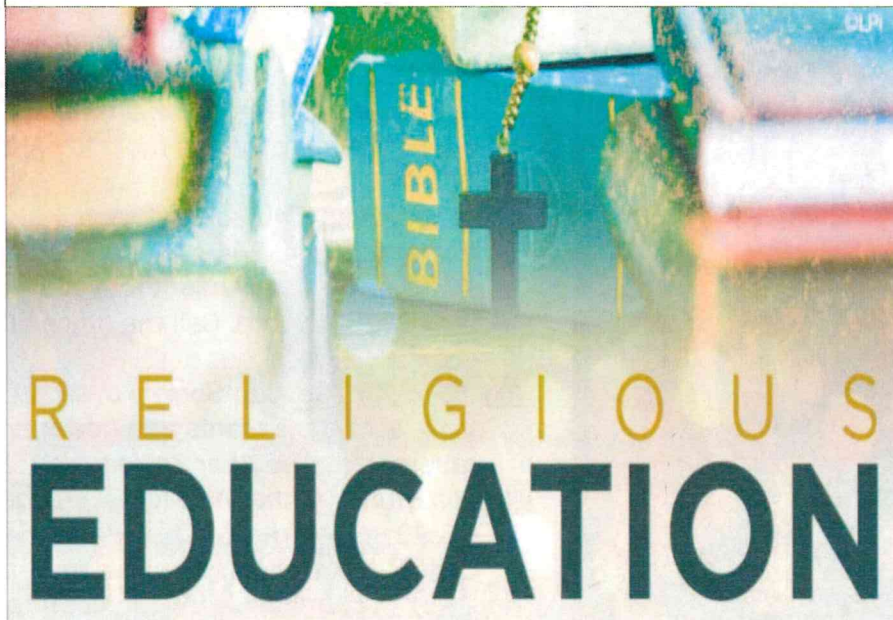
Parish Mission and Vision
